My most challenging financial management experience was as the Director of the local women's soccer league. Although numerous other players assisted with league responsibilities, I secured liability insurance annually, rented fields, bought equipment, created and managed a budget. My reward for these labors was that about 325 women had the opportunity to play soccer all year in my community. During my long tenure as director, I helped to integrate the league, negotiated contracts for discounted field space and handled referee complaints, created policy, drafted season schedules and mitigated misconduct issues. With three seasons throughout the year, I managed a soccer budget of about \$30,000 annually. The league never ran on a deficit and contributed substantially to a charity soccer tournament and memorial each year.
